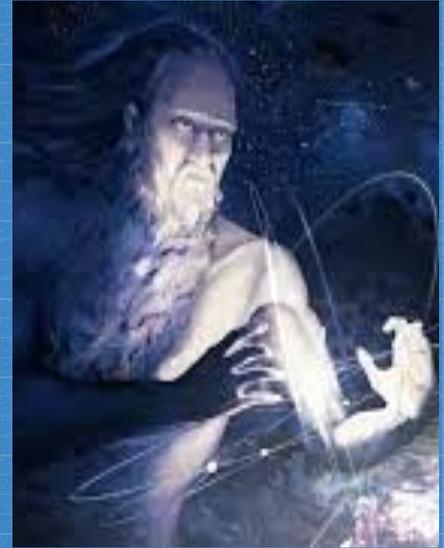

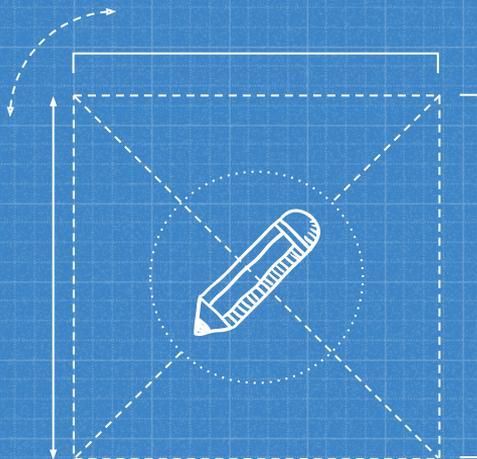
OUR TARGETS

The students and professors at these institutions, regardless of department, tend to have more personal wealth and are more likely to financially engage with campaigns they see as important.

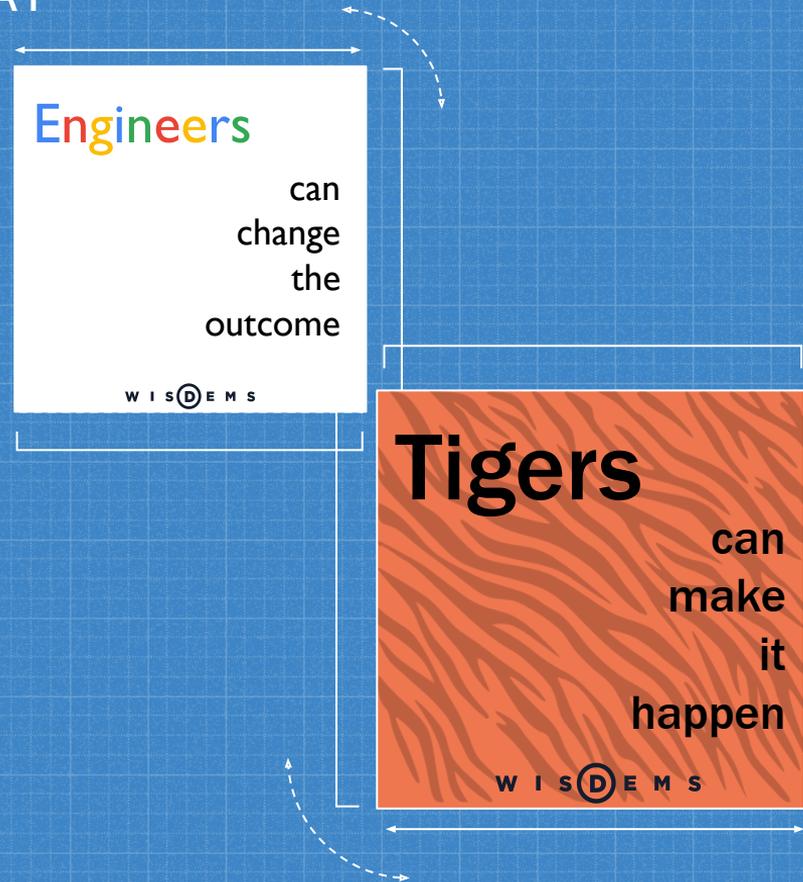


“YOU CAN CHANGE THE WORLD”
